IKF is the federation that oversees the Kempo/Kenpo modality, a martial art with high moral and ethical values that has been verified in all sporting events over the last 20 years.

The IKF annually develops various preventive and informative actions on good practices, ethics, sportsmanship, and the fight against violence, racism, and xenophobia.

The year 2025 was no exception:

- **Kempo For All** – National Programs of Ethics, Fair Play, Inclusion, and the fight against violence, racism, and xenophobia. Presented in schools, clubs, associations, coach training, referee training, and media all over the world.

Note: 100+ actions were carried out.

- **Kempo for All** – National Programs of Ethics, Fair Play, Inclusion and the fight against violence, racism and xenophobia. Presented at the IKF World Championship and Continental Championships, it was developed in 15 specific actions for an audience of 9000 people.

Note: 15 actions were carried out.

- **Coaches Courses** – similar to previous training sessions, future coaches were introduced to the importance of Ethics, Fair Play, Inclusion and the fight against violence, racism and xenophobia, reinforcing the need for reflection and inclusion in the training programme, as well as the responsibility of training the athletes' guardians.

Note: Several International Coach Training Courses were conducted in 2025, with 1000+ coaches involved.

- **Graduate Courses in Traditional Kempo and Sport Kempo** – Kempo is rooted in high ethical and moral values, being a traditionally inclusive modality averse to any type of ethical or moral failings, and intensely defends the fight against violence, racism, and xenophobia.

Note: 200 actions were carried out.

- **High Performance** – With 110 athletes in High Performance programmes, the IKF, together with the National Olympic Committees, has provided psychological support to athletes who have been victims of violence, intimidation, and xenophobia.

- **Inclusion of Foreign Citizens** – In the last 5 years, the IKF National Federations have experienced a 20% growth, a phenomenon also due to its capacity to include foreign citizens and its women's sports programmes. The growth of emigration to many countries, and the creation of women in Sports Programs have become a success.

- **KEMPI** – In 2025, the Portuguese Federation along with IKF decided to create a mascot, referencing Ethics, Fair Play, Inclusion, and the fight against violence, racism, and xenophobia. Several campaigns were launched using billboards, roll-ups, flyers, and social media.


